III. DHS Reports to CRP | Florence Calderon

- Budget: \$15,000 have not touched budget/minus Kona travel for members
- Flo will send org chart to members
- Hazard Pay: staff has sent in the needed data to support pay
 - Looking at possible pay out in October 2024
- Federal CRSR visit is coming up soon
- New secretary is Dana
 - o Maria will start maternity in mid-September
- Per Diem for CRP members: amount was list on TAF for travel
 - Flo shared process for getting travel approved for off island meetings/Travel Authorization Form (TAF)
 - Per Diem was listed on the Kona travel TAF
 - Members would need to submit boarding passes
 - Food: save receipts as it may need to be submitted in the future. CWS staff do not need to submit receipts
- CWS safety for staff when there are threats from parents/family members
- Chris: Are there any changes being made following the CWS audit report (RCG support)?
 - o Flo: at the end of the audit report there is a response from CWS
 - CWS is always looking at way to improve the work
 - Flo will reach out to Branch and Division to get a response regarding the audit and CWS response.
 - o If it's a contract, AGs are more diligent when reviewing to protect CWS from litigation
 - Gone are the cookie cutter contracts
 - AGs are ensuring all contract are created to meet the purpose

- G. By-Laws update- still with AG; waiting for return
 - No current movement
- b. Welcome documents review- PIO will be asked to upload our brochure
 - Monica: is now able to focus on this/would like to create a workgroup to look at the many CRP documents and create a welcome package for new CRP members
 - Want packet to be comprehensive but not overwhelming
 - These documents would be sent prior to becoming a member
 - FAQ and By-laws are normally given upfront
 - Flo wants members to review documents and update them as they are dated. It was last reviewed in 2013
 - Members to review all documents and collectively work on creating a welcome packet.
 - Flo will send members all documents that were previous sent to members
 - Members will review documents and decide what to include in welcome packet.
 - Bring ideas and comments to next meeting
 - Will add this to next months agenda item to cover this.
 - Brochure is not uploaded to <u>DHS Website</u>, last response letter 2016 posted in <u>archives</u> (update needed)
 - Flo has reached out via email regarding uploading brochure to DHS website. No response as of yet.
- C. **Recruitment**: Joe O'Connell(Hilo), Butch Gima(Lana'i), Karen Holt(Moloka'i), Kaileen Napeahi(Waianae) Sharla (EPIC)
 - Michelle: Will reach out to Keopu R. (former DHS communication)
 - Parent partner (lived experience) are able to be part panel as long as they have the minimal years following the closing of their case
 - Joe O'Connell: no concerns raised regarding his application APPROVED to advance to interview
 - Flo: informal interview/talk story panel as added new process
 - Interview panel: Chris, Michelle
 - Flo will email Joe and cc Chris and Michelle
 - Chris/Michelle will schedule interview with Joe
 - Outcome of interview will be shared with members at next meeting for final vote
- d. Heidi: On-going membership
 - Flo: there needs to be commitment to attend meetings regularly
 - Heidi has missed more than 3 meetings
 - Heidi has shared her workload has increase which has made it difficult for her to attend meetings regularly
 - She is the only member from Maui
 - Flo suggests Chris/Monica meet with Heidi to determine her commitment and capacity to continue with panel

- Concerns raised regarding Heidi commitment.
- There has been very minimal communication from her.
- Moving forward, expectations need to made clear
- Create a process for members to follow if they are unable to attend meetings and the expectations to stay updated by reading notes prior to next meeting.
- Get commitment to attend in-person meeting to build pilina (relationships).
- If she is unable to continue on panel can she refer someone from her island to ensure Maui is represented on panel
- Next Step: Chris and Monica will meet with Heidi and share expectations via zoom
- e. **CRP Annual Report response** 2023 Report is posted online, 2023 response need to be posted online. Chair and Co-chair will begin work on 2024 annual report and review with panel when a draft form has been produced
 - Monica and Chris worked on draft report for 2024
 - First two section are the same. Changes are the projects
 - Reports are due the end of fiscal year (end of July)
 - Panels to review report and send any input/updates to Chris or Monica by Monday.
 Plans are to submit report on Friday (7/23/24)
- f. **CSFR** We strongly encourage members to participate on their island when possible
 - Selective of community members participating. Prefer members to have some human or social service experience. Also must have a degree
 - Bring Angela Doi present to panel the CQI review
 - Noe: shared the importance for CWS line staff to participate in CQI reviews to understand the process. Pairing CWS line with a community member is beneficial
 - Add projects for 24-25 fiscal year
- g. CRP Annual Retreat
 - Look at planning a 1 to 2 day retreat this fiscal year.
 - Possibly to bring in NCRP speaker to hear what is happening nationally
 - Angela Doi to do CQI training/Trauma Inform training
 - Looking at a cultural component
 - Branch, Division, Director normally attends
 - Non-members cannot attend retreat/able to have an open house recruitment event before or after retreat
