TRANSFER SUMMARY

K [REDACTED] C [REDACTED]-V [REDACTED], age 12 came to the attention of the DHS due to physical abuse and neglect from his father, E [REDACTED] V [REDACTED], step-mother and adoptive sister. Permanent Custody of K [REDACTED] was awarded to the DHS on June 5, 1995.

K [REDACTED] has been in placement with his foster father, J [REDACTED] T [REDACTED], since June 12, 1992. Originally guardianship to Mr. T [REDACTED] was the goal, however, he has shared he would like to pursue permanent custody of K [REDACTED] instead. He does not want to do this until his two older foster children age out of the system later this year. Mr. T [REDACTED] is a distant relative by marriage of K [REDACTED]'s. Mr. T [REDACTED] understands the family dynamics that K [REDACTED] has come from and is very bonded to him.

K [REDACTED] is in Special Education at Hauula Elementary and will be going to Kahuku Intermediate and High School in the fall. There are some concerns regarding K [REDACTED]'s transition into a new setting. He is bonded to his teacher, Mr. Kawakami, who might be transferring to Kahuku.

K [REDACTED] receives therapy from Arthur Walker, Ph.D. Previously there has been concerns regarding K [REDACTED]'s relationship with animals. He was caught having sex with one of the dogs several years ago. Also, Mr. T [REDACTED] has stated he has caught K [REDACTED] in the horse stall with the horses. While Mr. T [REDACTED] did not see anything happening he was concerned as K [REDACTED] was in the stall for a long time. When questioned, K [REDACTED] stated he had difficulty placing the bridle on the horse. Of additional concern is K [REDACTED]'s rather flat affect when he has been injured and his fascination with fire. These problems have been addressed and will continue to be addressed with Dr. Walker.

K [REDACTED] enjoys fishing and was given a rod and reel last year. As a result he often drags his foster father to the beach to fish.

K [REDACTED] has not had contact with his sister, I [REDACTED] for a long time. She was on runaway status from August 1995 till March 1996. She is currently living with her father and step-mother and intends to stay there. If and when visits can be arranged, they should be supervised. He has expressed no real desire to meet with his other sister, Kuuipo, who Mr. T [REDACTED] feels is a bad influence upon him.
