ASSESSMENT:

Children: T [REDACTED] (age 9 years) remains under PC to J [REDACTED] T [REDACTED], a non-relative foster parent who specializes in working with troubled teenage boys. T [REDACTED] is doing well under J [REDACTED]'s guidance. The family still plans to relocate to the Big Island, but that has been pushed back until next year sometime (the original date was 11/99). DHS was kept as a party in the case in order to provide Mr. T [REDACTED] with whatever support he needed. Mr. T [REDACTED] also asked that I remain on the case for one more review period following the transfer of PC to him. Mr. T [REDACTED] is very experienced at this all and basically is able to handle the boys in his care somewhat independently (this sometimes causes friction between agencies and Mr. T [REDACTED]). I have known Mr. T [REDACTED] for over 10 years and know him to fight for the best interests of the boys, and he knows them better than anyone else. T [REDACTED] is quite fortunate to be with Mr. T [REDACTED] at this time, and it has shown in T [REDACTED]'s improved behavior. I can now be discharged at this time.

C [REDACTED] (age 12 years), A [REDACTED] (age 11 years), I [REDACTED] (age 8 years) and K [REDACTED] (age 5 years) remain together in a non-relative Casey Family home, awaiting their adoption. They have been in this home awhile, and things look good. The children have all unanimously indicated a strong desire to be adopted by this

family. PC was transferred to The Casey Family Program (TCFP) so that the adoption can be finalized. The honeymoon period is clearly over, as the children have had some problems in the home and in school, but nothing extraordinary. They are fortunate to have a family willing to adopt them together.


Agencies: DHS and TCFP have done well with these children.
