VIOLENCE IN THE HOME BETWEEN MS. F [REDACTED] AND MR. M [REDACTED]. ON 1/3/96,
PHYSICAL ABUSE TO L [REDACTED] M [REDACTED] BY HIS MOTHER WAS CONFIRMED. MRS.
F [REDACTED] REPORTED HERSELF TO THE DHS WORKER. ON 10/2/96 DHS RECEIVED
MORE REPORTS OF YELLING AND OTHER INCIDENTS IN THE F [REDACTED]/M [REDACTED] HOME.
IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT DHS HAD TRIED TO MAINTAIN THE FAMILY UNIT, HAD

SERVICES. ON 5/2/96M THE FOURTH CHILD, R [REDACTED] M [REDACTED] HAD BEEN BORN.

AT A COURT HEARING ON 10/18/96, THE COURT WAS FRUSTRATED BY THE LACK OF
COOPERATION AND PROGRESS OF THIS COUPLE AND ORDERED DHS TO TAKE CUSTODY OF
THE CHILDREN THAT DAY. FOSTER CUSTODY WAS ORDERED.

THE CHILDREN WERE PLACED IN THE HOME OF A MATERNAL AUNT, N [REDACTED] T [REDACTED]
AND SERVICES WERE OFFERED TO THE PARENTS.

FOR THE NEXT TWO YEARS, MRS, F [REDACTED] AND MR. M [REDACTED] DID NOT COMPLY WITH
THE COURT ORDERED SERVICE PLAN AND ON 3/18/98 A MOTION FOR PERMANENT
CUSTODY WAS FILED FOR ALL FOUR OF THE CHILDREN.

AT A COURT HEARING/JPA ON 4/23/98 THE PARENTS AGREED TO PERMANENT CUSTODY
OF THE TWO YOUNGER CHILDREN, R [REDACTED] (WHO IS [REDACTED] CHALLENGED) AND
R [REDACTED]. THE COURT SPLIT THE CHILDREN AND DHS WAS TO CONTINUE TO TRY
TO REUNITE THE TWO OLDER CHILDREN, L [REDACTED] AND R [REDACTED] WITH THEIR PARENTS.
ALTHOUGH MS. F [REDACTED] TESTED POSITIVE FOR DRUGS IN 8/98, THE COURT DID
NOT ORDER PC OF THE BOYS, AS WAS AGREED ON 4/23/98. FOR THE NEXT 18 MONTHS
THE BOYS WERE SUBJECTED TO VISITS WITH THEIR PARENTS WHICH SOMETIMES ENDED
WITH BRUISES AND OTHER INCIDENTS. BOTH BOYS GREW MORE AND MORE ANGRY.
FINALLY ON 12/9/99 THE COURT GRANTED PERMANENT CUSTODY OF L [REDACTED] AND
R [REDACTED].

THE PLACEMENT OF THE CHILDREN WAS ALSO AN ISSUE THAT CAUSED TRAUMA TO
THEM. IN 1998, MS. T [REDACTED], ALTHOUGH ONLY IN HER 30'S, SUFFERED A STROKE
AND THE CHILDREN ALL HAD TO BE REMOVED. AT THE POINT FORWARD, THE M [REDACTED]
CHILDREN WERE SEPARATED EFFECTIVE 6/30/98. L [REDACTED] AND R [REDACTED] WERE
TOGETHER UNTIL 10/3/98 WHEN THEY HAD TO BE SEPARATED DUE TO THE ANGER
AND VIOLENCE BETWEEN THEMSELVES AND TO OTHERS. SEPARATELY, THEY WERE EASIER
TO HANDLE.
