**ORDER GRANTING IN PART AND DENYING IN PART
MOTION TO CLARIFY OR AMEND ORDER**

Movant Gray Local Media's (Gray) Motion to Clarify or Amend Order, filed December 4, 2025 (Motion), was heard on April 8, 2026, at 9:00 a.m., before the Honorable Ronald G. Johnson, Judge of the above-entitled Court. R. Brian Black appeared for Movant. Amy M.H. Chan appeared for the Honolulu Police Department (HPD). Kurt Nakamatsu appeared for the Department of the Prosecuting Attorney.

After having considered the motion and memorandum, HPD's response filed March 30, 2026, the declarations and exhibits submitted and the authorities cited by both parties, the pleadings and other records in this case and Special Proceeding 93-9, and argument of counsel, it is hereby ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED, for the reasons stated by the Court at the hearing on this matter, as follows:

(1) The Motion is GRANTED to clarify that language in the July 3, 1995 Order of Limited Disclosure in the Special Secret (Investigatory) Grand Jury Session, entered in Special Proceeding 93-9, concerning disclosure ("disclosure of matters presented before the grand jury, . . . including testimony, documents and the contents contained

therein") is restricted to "matters occurring before the grand jury" within the scope of Hawai'i Rules of Penal Procedure (HRPP) 6(e) and the prevailing case law;


(2) In other respects, the Motion is DENIED;

(3) Matters occurring before the grand jury in Special Proceeding 93-9, within the scope of HRPP 6(e), remain sealed and protected from disclosure;

(4) Any disputes concerning disclosure of matters occurring before the grand jury, in Special Proceeding 93-9, may be brought to this Court; and

(5) Any disputes concerning disclosure of HPD records, including HPD's assertion of exceptions to public disclosure under the Uniform Information Practices Act, HRS chapter 92F, must be presented in a different forum.
