The government’s Opposition refers to and extensively discusses sealed filings, including but not limited to, the Government’s Sealed Motion at Dkt. 264 (hereinafter “Sealed Motion 264”) filed in *United States v. Jamey Denise Jackson*, Case No. CR22-00093-02-JMS (D. Haw.), which is one of the subjects of Public First Law Center’s motion to unseal. Exhibit A to the Opposition is a proposed redacted version of the Government’s Sealed Sentencing Memorandum at ECF No. 335 (hereinafter “Sentencing Memorandum”) filed in *United States v. Jamey Denise Jackson*, Case No. CR22-00093-02-JMS (D. Haw.).

Accordingly, the United States seeks leave to file a redacted public version of its Opposition, which redacts content that would disclose the nature and substance of Sealed Motion 264 and Sentencing Memorandum, or other sealed

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filings and confidential, sensitive, and non-public information (such as Presentence Investigation Reports), and file an unredacted version under seal and *ex parte*.
