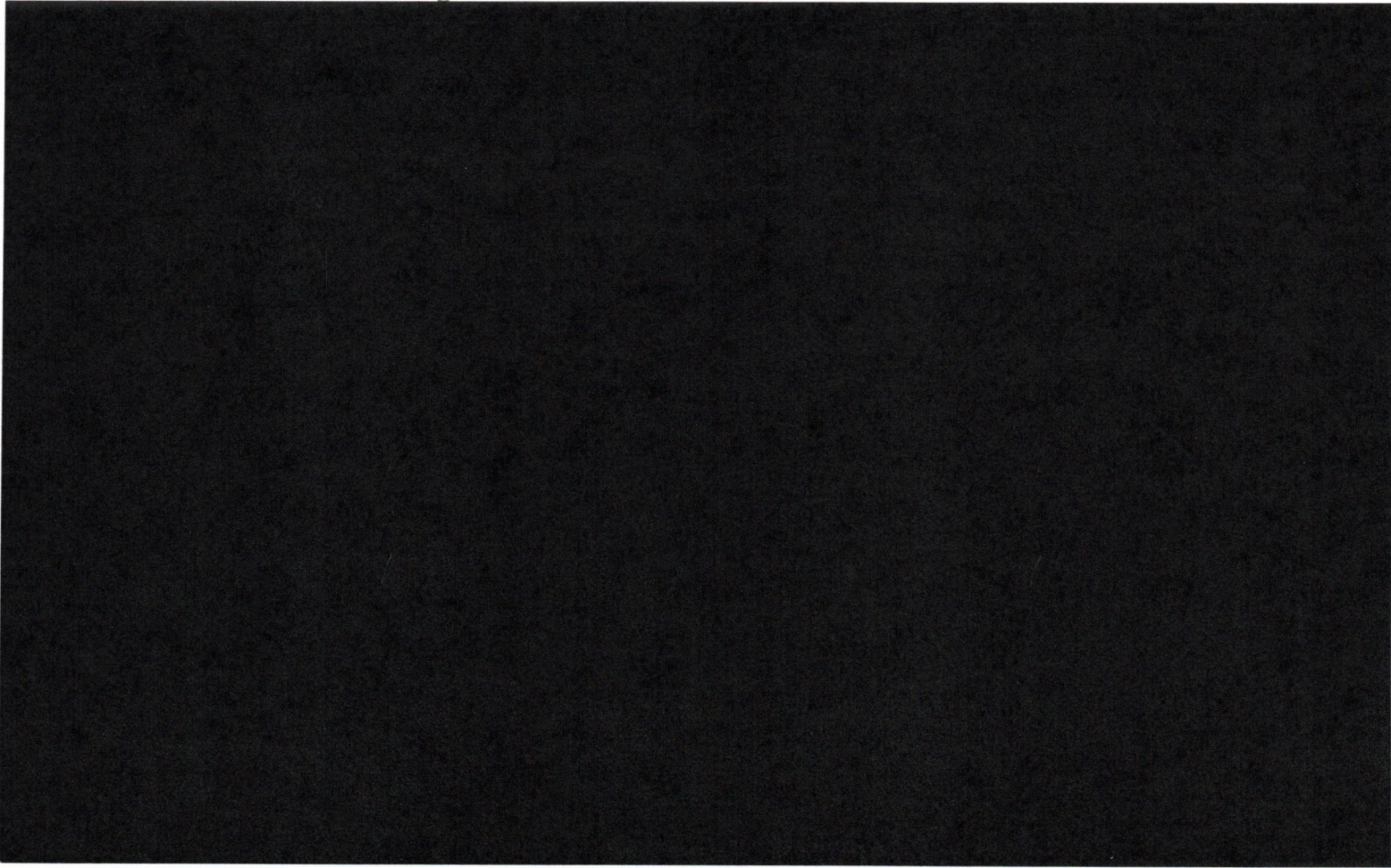

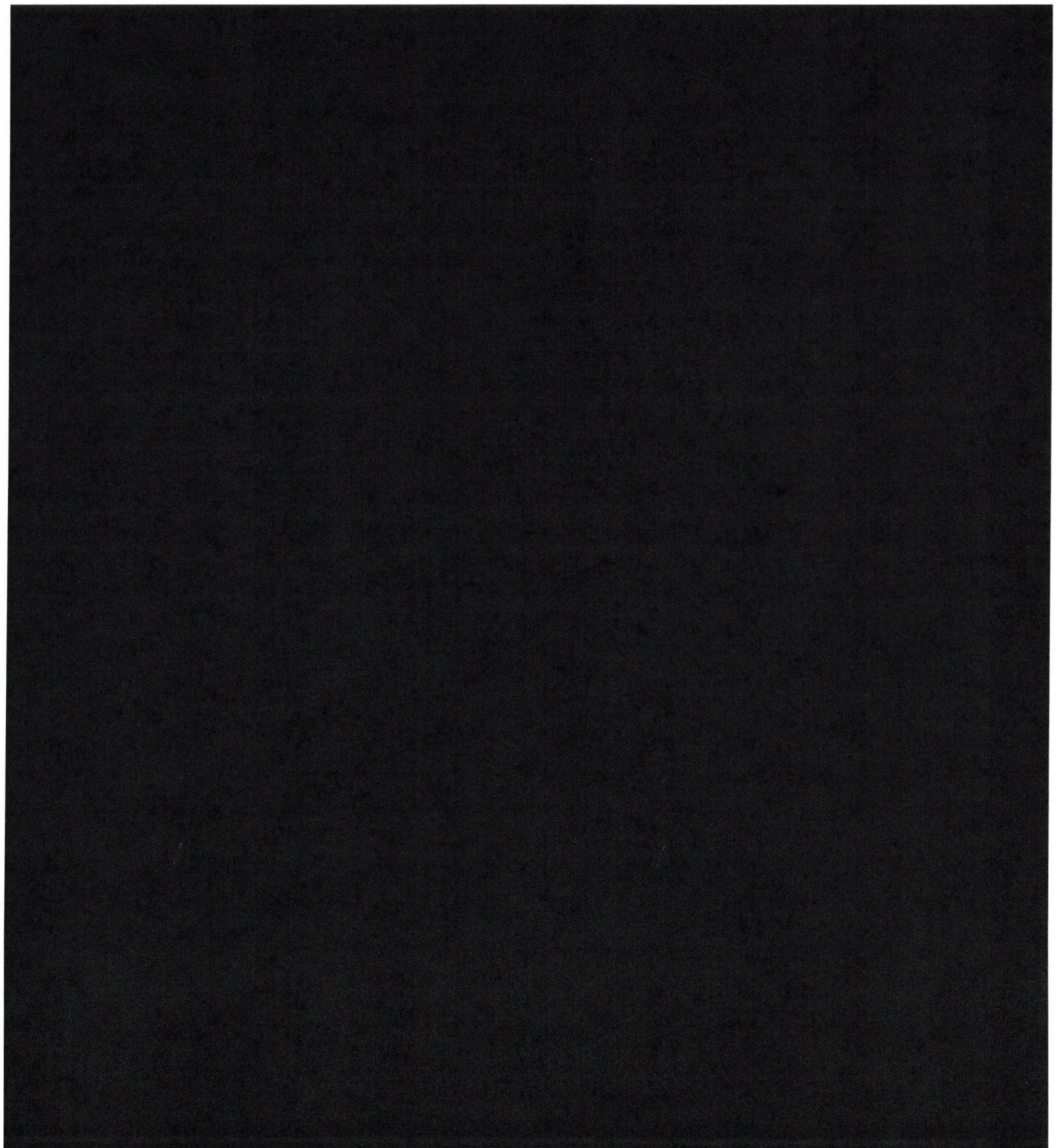
Offense Synopsis:

According to court minutes, the presentence report was waived by all parties.

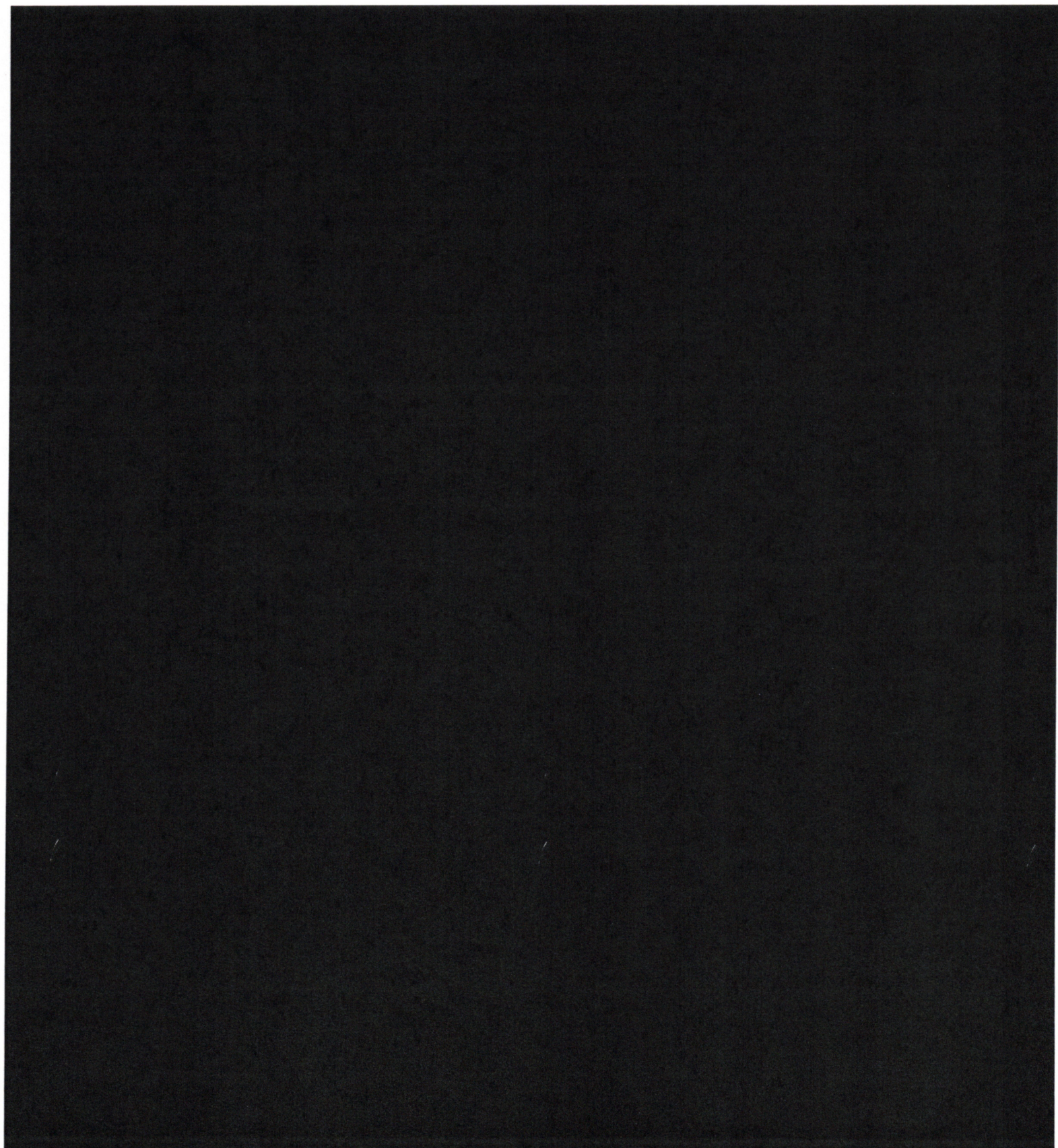
